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O I Tukai Lodge

The essence of Amboseli is Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak, which dominates everything in sight. The main attractions of the National Park are the large elephant population and the prolific birdlife. There are few trees in Amboseli and part of its attraction is the ease and certainty of game viewing, unobstructed by bush and scrub.

For most of the year Lake Amboseli is a dry soda bed that produces mirages on a fantastic scale. When you see wildebeest, or zebra, or best of all a herd of giraffe shimmering against the backdrop of Mount Kilimanjaro, you are watching one of the sights of Africa. And you can see that from the terrace outside your room.



O I Tukai is camouflaged in a forest of fever trees and palms.



From your room stretches a panorama of landscape, sky and wildlife with the massive majesty of snow-capped Kilimanjaro in the background.

Cottage style accommodation spreads out on either side of the main lodge. The architecture is unobtrusive with lots of wood, local stone and slate. Unusually there are two double rooms especially designed for the disabled and ramps for wheelchairs are the norm.



If you arrive at lunchtime there's time for a swim and a siesta before the late afternoon game drive to view the

profusion of game and birdlife supported by Amboseli National Park. Elephants are the acknowledged stars.

Over 1000 of them flourish here and the number is rising. "Intelligent, complicated, intense, tender, powerful and funny," is the description given
